We thank God for a new AWANA season and the opportunity to encourage your children to memorize Scripture - God's words to us. We are thankful that you have decided to join us. "AWANA" stands for "Approved Workmen Are Not Ashamed" and is taken from the Bible (2 Timothy 2:15). The following information may be helpful to you. Please let us know if you have any questions.

CLUB COSTS

The cost **per child** in Cubbies/Sparks/T&T is **\$30** for the AWANA year. This includes dues, handbook, uniform, and awards)

If there is any difficulty making the payment; simply pay as you are able. Please don't prevent your child from joining because of financial concerns. **It is our desire that all children have the opportunity to participate in AWANA and hide God's Word in their hearts.**

We also welcome additional financial donations to help fully fund this valuable ministry.

REGISTRATION/MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Every new club year, we ask that parents fill out a new **CLUB ACTIVITY PERMITT** for each child.

If your child is new to club they will become a member by completing the entrance booklet for their grade and attending 3 consecutive club nights. Once your child is a member, he or she is eligible to purchase their handbook & uniform. The handbook is essential for the handbook/scripture memory segment of the evening and the uniform is proudly worn to display the awards your child will earn.

CLUB SCHEDULE

Our clubs meet weekly on Wednesday evenings, 6:45 to 8:15 p.m.

Each child should check in at the table outside the sanctuary. This is an opportunity to pay any dues, buy books or update any contact information. Once checked in, the clubbers and leaders all meet in the gym for opening exercises where we salute the American and AWANA flags, sing, and hear announcements. Once dismissed, leaders will escort the clubbers to their various classes.

For security reasons, we ask that an adult pick up your Cubbie or Sparky in their classrooms. Please be respectful of the leader's time and pick up promptly.

The children break up into groups based on their age/grade. **Cubbies** (3-4 yr olds), **Sparks** (K-2nd grade), and **Truth & Training** (3rd - 6th grades). Each club meeting is comprised of three main segments: Handbook time, Council time and Game time.

HANDBOOK TIME

Handbook time provides opportunities for children to recite or complete sections from their handbooks. When the leader is satisfied that the clubber has covered the handbook material adequately, he/she will sign the book.

COUNCIL TIME

Council time is a time for singing, praising God, praying and having a Bible lesson covering a variety of topics.

GAME TIME

Game time offers clubbers the opportunity to participate as team members in physical activities that develop team spirit, good sportsmanship, and coordination skills. We encourage parents to have children dress comfortably for play and to **wear sneakers**.
